

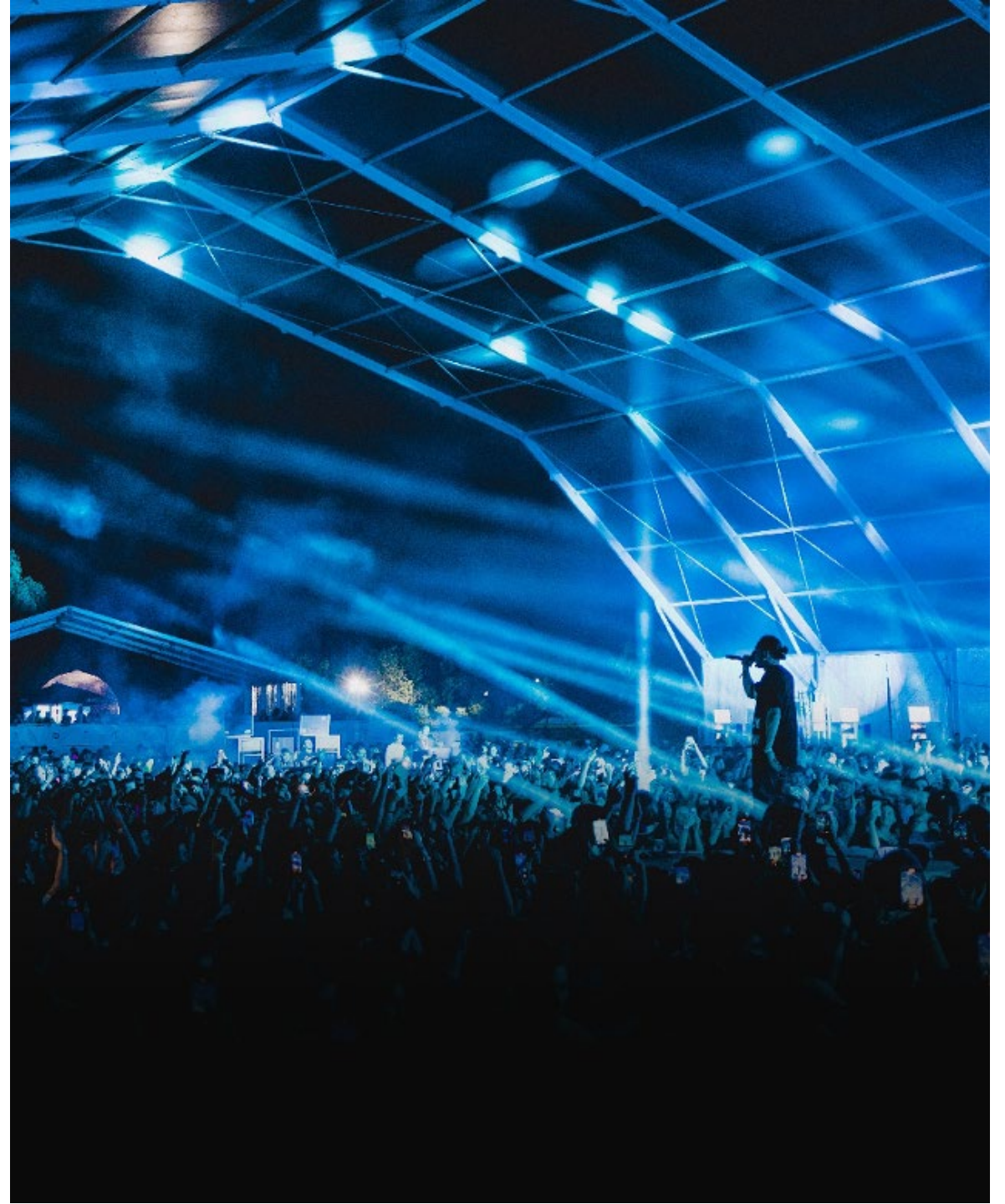


Key features of Outdoor Event Lighting

to ensure the comfort of participants.

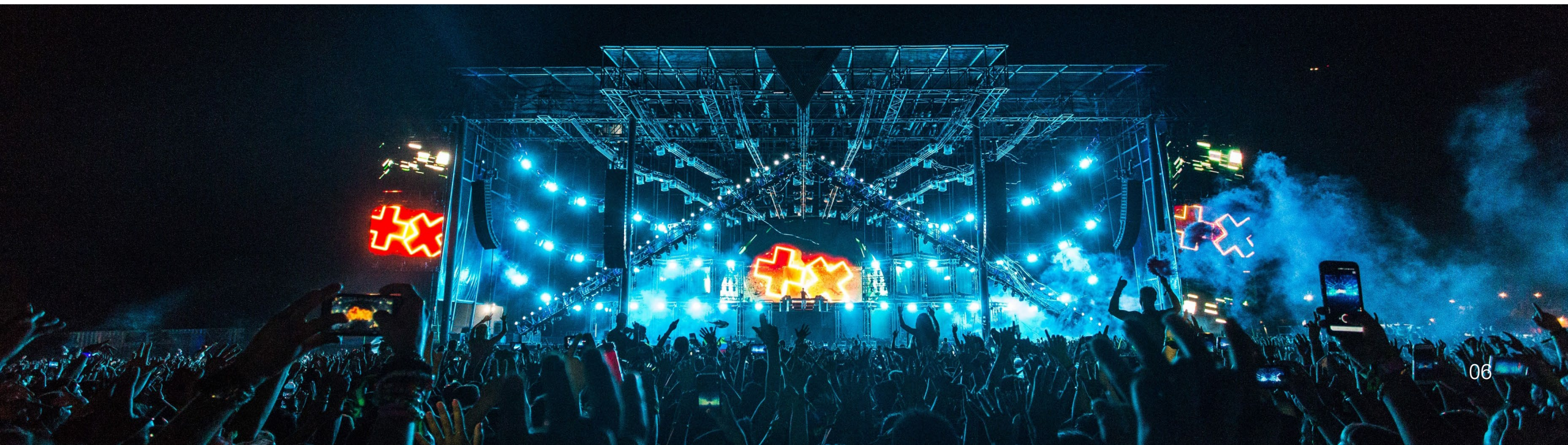
Environmental lighting
